HIGHLIGHTS

- **Bolivia:** Upgraded the kitchen and improved food sustainability
- **Dominican Republic:** Inaugurated a transitional home in Monte Plata for children in need and emergency situations with the goal of reintegrating them into family structures
- **El Salvador:** Opened a daycare center that serves people in the community and *Hermanos Mayores* ("older siblings") who grew up at NPH
- **Guatemala:** Launched the NPH OneFamily program to reintegrate and support youth from the NPH home who are now able to live with their biological families
- **Haiti:** Celebrated 30th Anniversary, and completed many repairs at St. Helene, the main home
- **Honduras:** Received a 93% effectiveness rating from the Honduran National Directorate for Children, Youth, and Family, placing it among the top three homes in the nation
- **Mexico:** Assisted people affected by the September earthquake despite suffering millions of dollars in damages at two NPH sites
- **Nicaragua:** Completed construction of the secondary school, which includes eight classrooms, a lab and a library
- **Peru:** Expanded psychological services with two volunteers working in language and learning therapy, and one in art therapy
