More than half the children in the developing world are severely deprived of one or more basic necessities, including adequate shelter, proper nutrition, safe water and quality health care. Millions have never been to school. They beg and scavenge to survive.

The facts are devastating. But there is hope.

### 50 YEARS OF TRANSFORMING LIVES

Founded in 1965, NPH USA supports the Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH, Spanish for "Our Little Brothers and Sisters") network of homes in Latin America and the Caribbean. Together, we transform the lives of orphaned, abandoned and disadvantaged children and enable them to grow into caring and productive members of their communities.

NPH has cared for over 18,000 children to date and is currently raising more than 3,200 children boys in girls in Bolivia, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, and Peru. An additional 2,300 students who live outside the homes receive scholarships, meals, and health care. NPH community outreach programs focused on healthcare, education, and basic needs provided more than 100,000 services in 2016.

### WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

- Our children receive direct physical, emotional and spiritual support on a long-term basis.
- Our children are not available for adoption – they are welcomed into a family for life which gives them security and a sense of belonging.
- Our children have daily chores, such as dusting, mopping, cooking or farming. This teaches them responsibility and they find pride in helping their family in this way.
- Our children are given a quality education and have the opportunity to pursue a trade or university degree.
- Our children give back a year or more of service to share the responsibility of raising the family.

Children/youth fully supported: 113

Features: Dining hall, school (grades 1-6), and clinic

### **Dominican Republic** | Opened: 2003

Children/youth fully supported: 222

Total services provided: 2,130

Features: 50 acres of land, school (grades K-11), clinic, farm, greenhouse and gardens

DAILY OPERATING COST: \$2,225

### **El Salvador** | Opened: 1999

Children/youth fully supported: 228

Total services provided: 1,086

Features: School (grades K-9), vocational workshops, clinic, and farm

DAILY OPERATING COST: \$4,343

### **Guatemala** | Opened: 1996

### **Haiti** | Opened: 1987

Features: 15 acres of land, primary school (grades 1-8), and a farm. Special facilities include St. Damien Pediatric Hospital, which provides more than 80,000 services each year, and Fr. Wasson Angels of Light homes and schools for children displaced by the 2010 earthquake.

### **Honduras** | Opened: 1985

Features: School (grades K - 9), farm, special homes for disabled children and elderly adults, clinics, and a surgery center

### **Mexico** | Opened: 1954

Children/youth fully supported: 743

Total services provided: 2,214

Features: The main home in Miacatlán has a clinic, chapel, farms, and primary and secondary schools. There is housing and a vocational high school in Cuernavaca, and a home in Matamoros.

### **Nicaragua** | Opened: 1994

Total services provided: 353

Features: School (grades K-11), vocational workshops, farms, greenhouses, clinic, and water recycling system

Features: 15 acres of land, solar water heaters, clinic, and therapy center

DAILY OPERATING COST: \$1,257
