**Nov. 9** – Breakfast included at hotel, Antigua volcano hike, lunch on own, visit and dinner at NPH home.

**Nov. 10** – Breakfast included at hotel, Lake Atitlan visiting

religious/cultural/historical sites, lunch and dinner on own.

**Nov. 11** – Breakfast included at hotel, a full day at NPH Guatemala home lunch and dinner at NPH Guatemala home.

**Nov. 12** – Breakfast included at hotel, Antigua coffee plantation excursion, lunch on own, visit and dinner at NPH home.

**Nov. 13** – Breakfast included at hotel, Transport to Guatemala City - Travel day home, lunch and dinner on own.

Opened in 1996, NPH Guatemala is home to approximately 100 children. The home, Casa San Andres, is located 90 minutes west of Guatemala City, the nation's capital. It is situated 5,800 feet above sea level in Guatemala's beautiful central highlands, very close to the famous colonial capital of Antigua Guatemala. Casa San Andres has approximately 25 acres of land with a Montessori preschool/ kindergarten, primary and middle schools, vocational workshops, clinic, athletic fields, a farm and areenhouses.
